Silver City Masonic Lodge Scholarship

\$500 is awarded to a boy and a girl from one of the three following schools: Marsing, Homedale and Wilder. Disbursement will be made by mailing funds to the college of your choice upon completion of your enrollment 2nd semester.

Frank Matteson Memorial Scholarship

\$500 will be awarded to a hardworking student who has distinguished himself or herself in academics, athletics and/or extracurricular activities. The Matteson family will determine the winner.

Bryan Tolmie Memorial Scholarship

\$500 is awarded to the 2 outstanding senior male athletes at Homedale High School. An athlete who has been the most inspirational to fellow athletes through: **1)** participation in 3 sports during his senior year; **2)** enthusiasm for life – demonstrated by spirit in athletics; **3)** willingness to work hard to improve skills before, during and after each sport season; **4)** dedication to God, family, school, friends, teammates, coaches, and fellow classmates and; **5)** citizenship in church, school, and community. The head coaches of boy's sports and the athletic director will determine the award.

Carol Lopez Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship will be awarded to a female student interested in studying in the medical field. It will be based on a combination of need and grades. Adriana Madsen (sister) will determine the scholarship recipient and award the \$500.00 to the college upon proof of enrollment.

Mary Jo Pottenger Scholarship

Mary Jo Pottenger lived in Homedale 49 years. She started teaching in the Homedale School District in 1966. For the next 35 years she taught Math and other subjects in the Junior High and High School. As a dedicated educator, she spent countless hours tutoring current and former students even in her home. Her passion was to develop young men and women to achieve their academic and personal potential. She loved to help students learn and her commitment to teaching was valued by parents, faculty and the community. This \$1000 scholarship seeks to recognize a student, who has shown interest and commitment to math and/or education of others. The application information and behaviors observed by Homedale High School Faculty and Staff will be the selection criteria.

Conner Landa Athletic Scholarship

\$500 is awarded to one senior athlete who participates in at least 2 varsity sports and has a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher. The Conner Landa Memorial Board will select the recipient.

Conner Landa FFA Agricultural Scholarship

\$500 is awarded to one senior who is a member of the Future Farmers of America and has a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher. The Conner Landa Memorial Board will select the recipient.

Evelyn Hood Memorial Scholarship

\$300 is awarded to one senior who has a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher who plans on majoring in Education. The Homedale High School faculty and staff will choose recipient.

Robert and Elaine Batt Vo-Tech Student Scholarship

A total of \$2500 is divided and awarded to seniors who have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher who plan on seeking a career in the Vo-Tech field (For example: welders, electricians, plumbers, diesel mechanics, carpenters, equipment operators and nurses) The Ag department and Mr. Holtry will select the recipients.
