



# LEWIS-CLARK STATE COLLEGE

The Dual Credit program at Lewis-Clark State College offers students the opportunity to enroll in dual credit academic courses and to earn both high school and college credit while experiencing the rigor and intellectual challenge of college classes.

### ***The Benefits of Dual Credit:***

You are getting a jump start on a college education with an official college transcript! These credits have the potential to be transferred to other colleges for application toward a degree. Credit transferability is always up to the receiving institution. Check [www.lcsc.edu/admissions](http://www.lcsc.edu/admissions) for a list of course equivalency guides for schools to which we frequently transfer credits.

### ***Advanced Opportunities/ Fast Forward Funding:***

The Fast Forward Provides every Idaho high school students a total of \$4,125 for the duration of grades 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>. For more information, ask your high school counselor, visit <http://www.sde.idaho.gov/site/advancedopp/>, or contact LCSC Dual Credit at 208.792.2209.

### ***Tuition Costs:***

In the case that you do not have any more state funding available, the tuition cost for classes held at the high-school are \$65 per credit. The payment deadline for 2017 will be October 20th. Please be sure to pay your bill before then, as late payments are subject to late fees of \$50. If you do not pay by October 20<sup>th</sup> you will be removed from your course through Lewis-Clark State College.

### ***Ways to pay:***

If you end up owing money once your fast forward funding has been used, there are several ways to get payment by the October 20th deadline:

- Please Note \* A non-refundable service fee of 2.5% will be assessed, in addition to the amount you are paying, for all credit and debit card payments.

**Process to register for Dual Credit through LCSC:**

Please follow the checklist below and make sure you get your form to us by September 20<sup>th</sup>, 2017

- Print off the registration form attached to your email.
- Fill out all of the fields on the registration form. Please make sure everything is complete, such as DOB and your social security number.
- The grid box below needs to be filled out with the information that I have filled out in RED. \* Please refer to the section number for your school in the main email sent out.

- Make sure to obtain all signatures from the following: Parent/Guardian, Counselor and yourself.
- Keep a copy of the front and back of the form as it includes all the information that you will need afterward.
- If you still have state funding, make sure to work with your counselor to apply.** If you do not, please remember payment for each course will be October 20<sup>th</sup> in the amount of \$195 per course
